
Ruthie Russell and family receive 2014 Texas Parks and Wildlife Lone Star Land Steward Award... read more

#### Flows of the Llano

The Llano River at Junction is flowing just over 40 cfs. The Median flow for this period is about 110 cfs. The current flow is similar to flows seen the first week of January 2013.
